



## **Assembly Instructions**

#### Step 1:


Put Body Hopper (#2) upside down and insert legs (#3). Align holes on legs and attach Lock Pin (A)

Hardware:

#A - 4 pcs

Using 2 adults, stand feeder upright on the pipe legs


WARNING: Feeder is heavy!

### Step 2:


Secure Lid (#1) with latches to hopper



Your feeder assembly is completed.

### Step 3:

Secure feeder to ground with Stakes (not included) through loops on legs




## **Operating Instructions**

#### **Connecting Battery**

Install a 12V rechargeable battery (not included) by attaching Red alligator clip to the POSITIVE (+) terminal and Black alligator clip to the NEGATIVE (-) terminal.

\*Digital Timer is preconnected to motor.



## **HOW TO OPERATE THE TIMER**


READ THE OPERATION MANUAL INCLUDED IN THE PACKAGE.

#### **Using Solar Panel**

Loosen the bolt (preattached on hopper) to set position of solar panel

Connect solar panel to battery

Note: Leave Solar Panel closed if worried about cattle or other animals damaging it.



### **HOW TO LOAD YOUR FEEDER**

OPEN THE LID AND POUR FEED INTO THE HOPPER. AFTER FILLING, CLOSE THE LID.


#### **TIPS & POINTERS:**

- (Q) What kind of feed should I use?
- (A) Whole kernel corn is recommended. Whole kernel corn mixed with soybeans or pellets is also effective for attracting deer. NOTE: When not mixed with corn, some types of pellets can take on moisture and clog the feeder.

### **Care and Maintenance**

- INSPECT FEEDER FOR ANY LOOSE PARTS OR HARWARE REGULARLY
- CHECK IF FEEDER IS TAKING WATER ON RAINY DAYS. SEAL GAP WITH SILICONE SEALANT IF NECESSARY
- IF RUST APPEARS ON THE EXTERIOR SURFACE OF FEEDER, CLEAN AND BUFF THE AFFECTED AREA WITH STEEL WOOL OR FINE GRIT EMERY CLOTH. TOUCH-UP WITH A GOOD QUALITY PAINT
- STORE FEEDER INDOORS WHEN NOT IN USE
- CLEAN FEEDER HOPPER REGULARLY TO AVOID CLOGGING AND DAMAGE TO THE CONTROL UNIT

## **Warranty Information**

- 1. Manufacturer warrants this product to be free from defects in workmanship and materials for a period of 90 days from the date of purchase, PROVIDED claims are submitted, in writing, with proof of purchase.
- 2.
