

# **QUAD VOLLEYBALL COURT DIAGRAM 12FT**







#### **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

Remove all the parts from the box and verify that you have all of the listed parts as shown on the parts list page. Set up will require 2 people.







#### - NOTE -

Find both sets of Pole Sets (#1). Assemble one set of poles as shown. At this time you should also assemble the other pole set.

Take one of the Scoring Rings (#13) slide it over the bottom of pole sets until you reach the numbered center pole. This will help you to keep track of your score while you play. Repeat process for the other pole.





#### - NOTE -

Person #1: Hold pole #1 upright.

Person #2: Hold pole #2 upright.

Person #3: Hold pole #3 upright.

Person #4: Hold pole #4 upright.

Find four **Ground Stabilizers** (# 6)
and insert one into the bottom of each pole.


#### **QUAD VOLLEYBALL**

#### COURT SETUP AND PLAY:

- 1. Decide which quadrants will be assigned squares #1-4. Fill the 4 spaces with players. Extra players may wait on the sideline. Choose either the Jumbo Volleyball or regulation size Volleyball for play.
- 2. Play begins with the ball being served from square #4. Service may only take place in the #4 square and points may only be scored when you are in that square. (see Scoring for more info)
- 3. The ball must always be served diagonally to square #2. The player in square #2 may not receive serve with a spike, but after square #2 returns the ball, spikes are allowed. Serve receive may be returned to any other square.
- 4. Players may only hit the ball once per return. Like regular volleyball, you may not catch or carry the ball during play. When a ball enters a player's square, it is that player's resposibility for returning and playing the ball.
- 5. If you fail to return the ball to another square you are eliminated. Failure to return the ball can be defined as:
  - A. Not returning the ball to another square
  - B. Letting the ball hit the ground in your own square
  - C. Hitting the ball out of bounds
  - D. Catching, holding or carrying the ball
- 6. If you are eliminated you must return to square #1 or allow player's on the sideline to filter in. All other players will then rotate clockwise to the next highest square.

Scoring – Points are only accumulated the 4th square while serving and without mistake. You keep your points when eliminated. Games are played till 11 points, Winning by 2.

**Note:** If a ball lands on the boundary line it is considered in play and that player would be eliminated. House rules do apply if you prefer to allow more hits per return or other rule variations.







### NOTE -

Adjust the Center Pole (#2) so that it is straight. Incrementally

adjust the Guy Rope (#3) tension to remove all slack from the ropes until all the lines to the set are secure.

DO NOT over-tighten lines.








Begin by finding the orange Boundary Kit Line Markers (#12). Clip the caribiner through the hole in the base of an Outer pole. From there, pull the line straight down until you reach the loop. Secure the loop with a Boundary Kit Foam Marker (#10) and Boundary Kit Stake (#11). Continue at a 90 degree angle to clip the other end of the line marker to the bottom of the next pole, essentially squaring off the 6ft x 6ft section of play. When complete you will have 4 clearly lined off quadrants.






Pole (#2) as shown. Insert Ground Stabilizers (# 6) into the bottom of pole.



Attach Net (#4). Person #1: Slide the sleeve net over the pole and pop the net through the opening for the pre-installed hooks on the inner sides of the pole. Stretch net out to Person #2 holding their pole upright and repeat on the other side. Repeat for the other 2 poles to help make your quad shaped court.



Place Black Pole Cap (#5) on top of assembled poles.







#### Insert Center Pole (#2) up through the center of the Quad Net Sections (#4).





With another person, hold up two of the pole sets straight across from each other so you have (2) 6 foot sections stretched out straight.

of the Top Double Guy Ropes (#3) to the top pole hook. Holding both ropes, walk away from the center of the pole, then walk one of the ropes 5 ft (1.5m) to the left of dead center, and the other rope 5ft (1.5m) to the right of dead center. Insert U-Shaped **Ground Stakes** (#9) through key rings at the end of the guy ropes and put the ground stake into the ground so that the guy rope is at a 45-degree angle from the pole. This step is repeated for poles 2-4.
