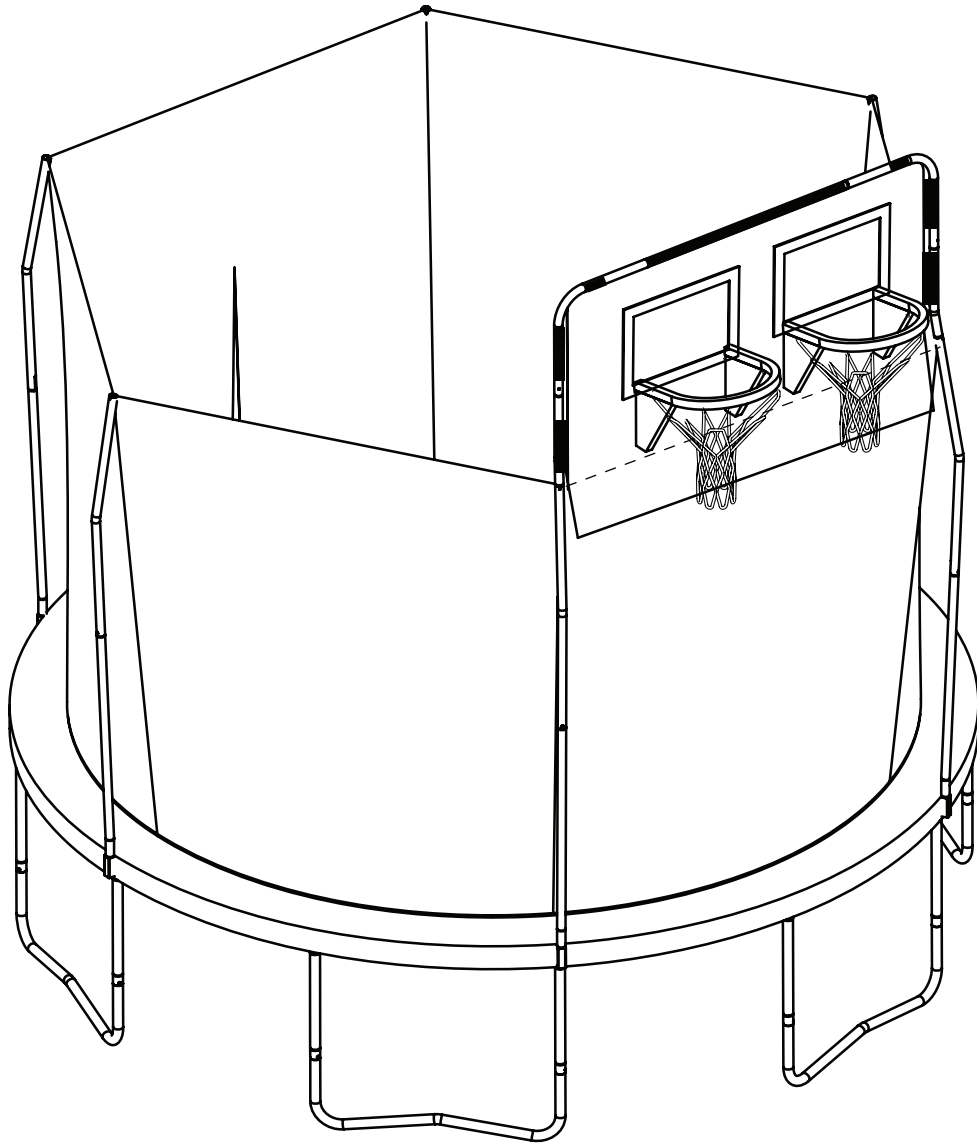

When calling, make sure to have the following information ready:

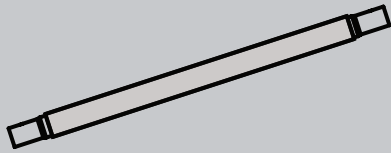
- The model # of the product (see the front cover of this manual)

EXPLODED DRAWING

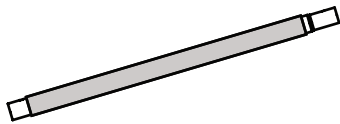

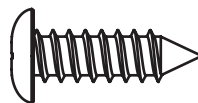
STEP 1



1 Middle Tube 1 with Foam (x1)

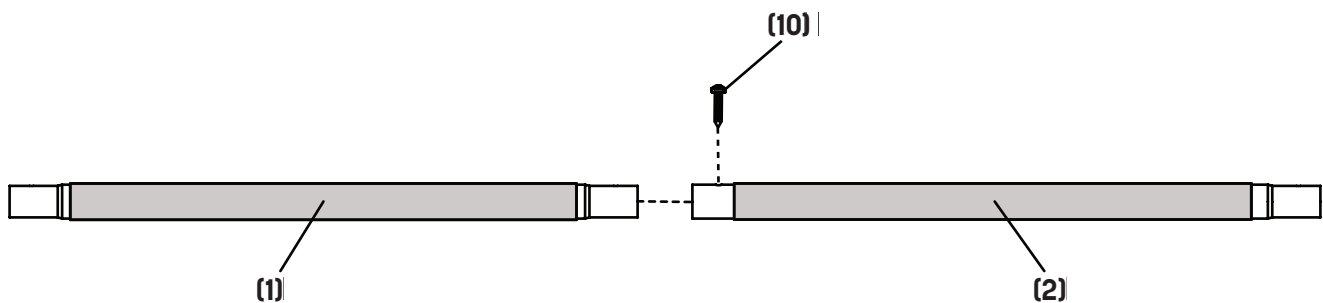


2 Middle Tube 2 with Foam (x1)

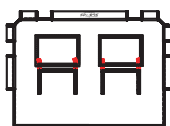


10 Self-tapping Screws (x1)

Insert the middle tube 1 with foam **(1)** into middle tube 2 with foam **(2)** as shown, and secure using one self-tapping screw **(10)**.



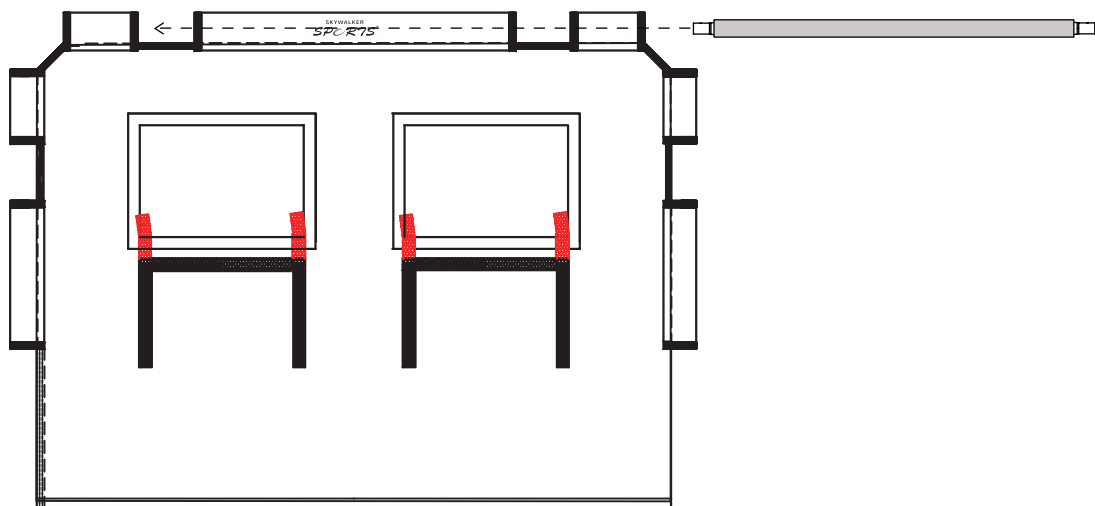
STEP 2



5 Backboard (x1)

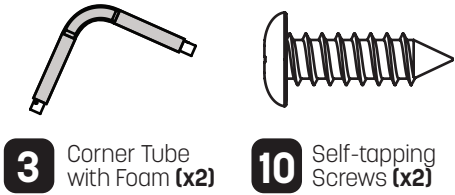
Place the backboard **(5)** on the ground, and insert the assembled middle tube with foam into the top sleeve as shown.

You've got this!



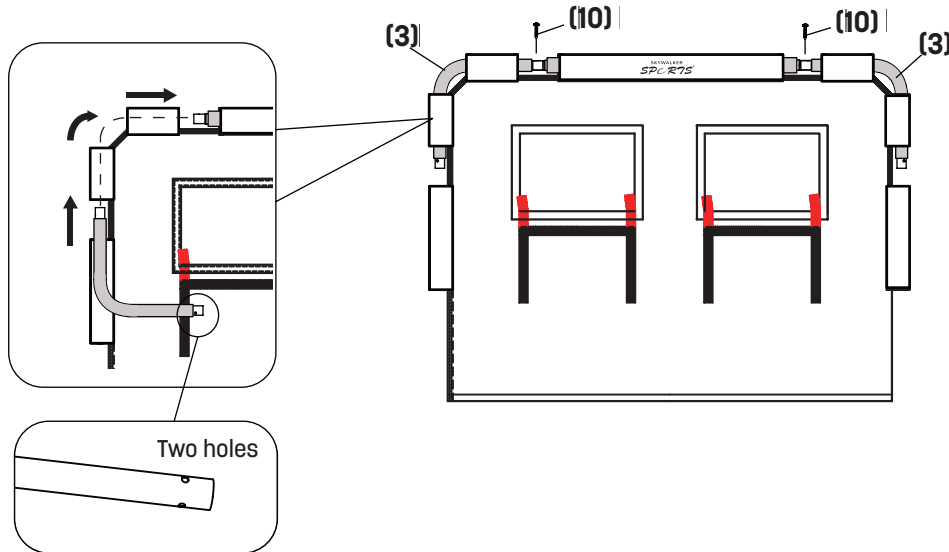

STEP 3

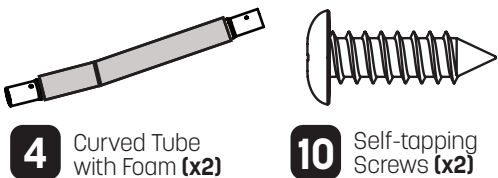


Insert the corner tubes with foam **(3)** into the sleeve as shown, and secure on each side using two self-tapping screws **(10)**.

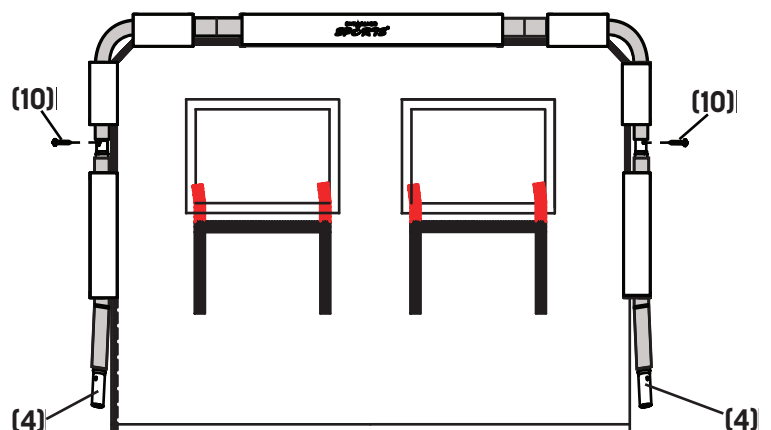
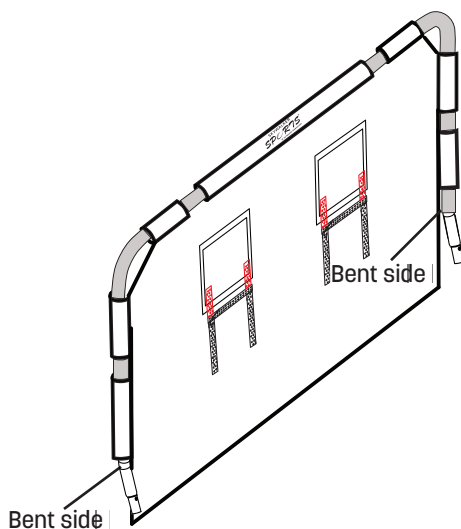
Note: One end of the corner tube has one hole, and the other end has two holes. You are connecting the end with one hole.



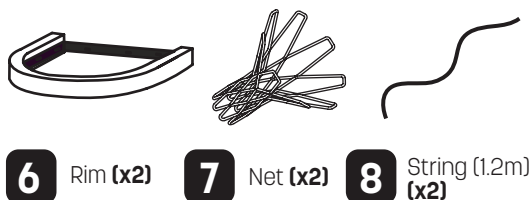
STEP 4



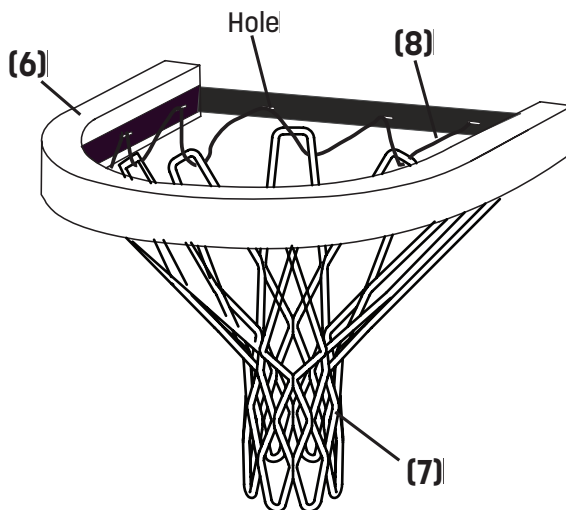
If you want the hoops to face inwards: Insert the curved tube **(4)** into the sleeve, making sure the bent side **curves toward the back**. Secure using two self-tapping screws **(10)**. **If you want the hoops to face outwards:** Insert the curved tube into the sleeve, making sure the bent side **curves towards the front**. Secure using two self-tapping screws.



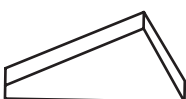
STEP 5



Take one end of the string **(8)** and tie a knot at the end. Begin threading the other end of the string through the left hole on the rim **(6)**. Weave the string in and out of the holes on the rim and the net **(7)** to attach completely. Make sure to regularly tighten the string. Once you've made it all the way around the rim, tie a knot at the end of the string to secure.



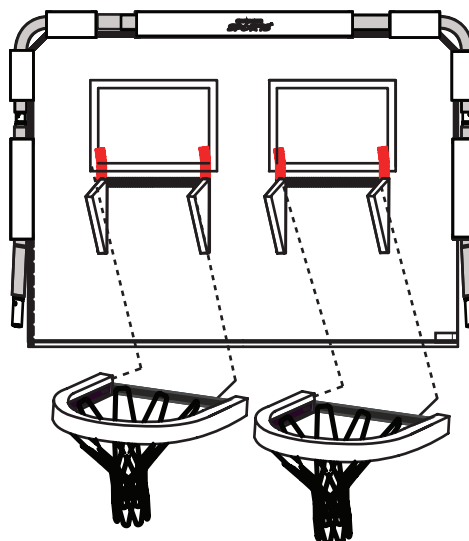
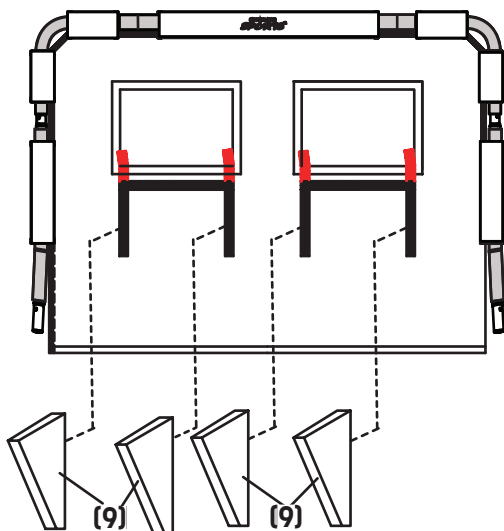
STEP 6



9 Support Block (x4)

Attach the 4 support blocks **(9)** to the backboard **(5)** using the provided velcro.

Then, attach the ring with net to the backboard. You're almost done!

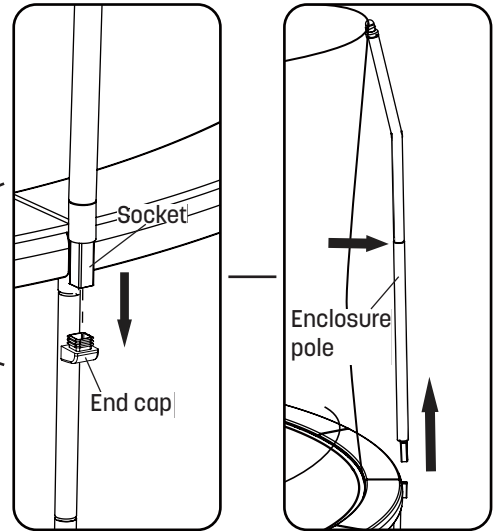
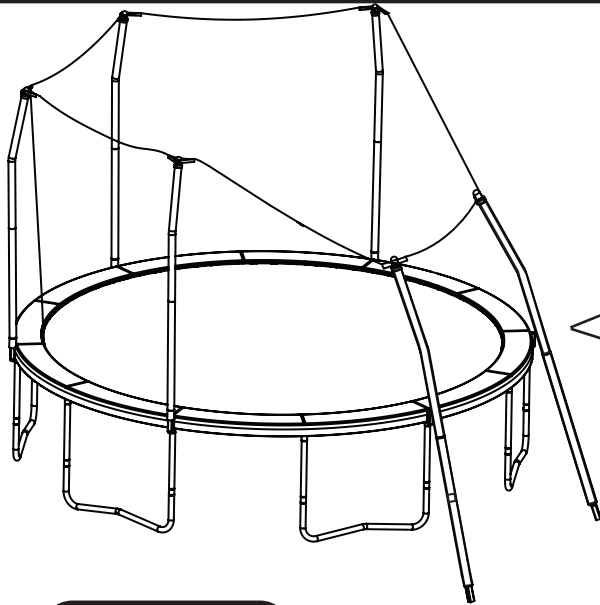

STEP 7

To attach the game to your trampoline you will need to lower the two enclosure poles you will be mounting to. (Additional poles may also need to be lowered in order to release some of the tension from the enclosure net.) Remove the pole caps from the two chosen enclosure poles.

Helpful tip: When removing the enclosure poles, pull back on the middle of the poles!

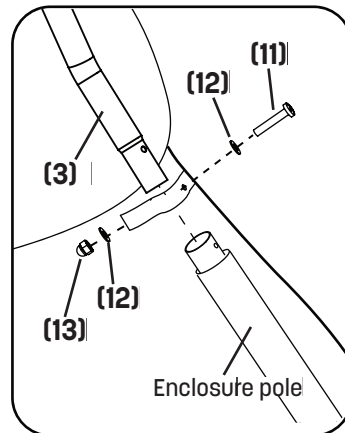
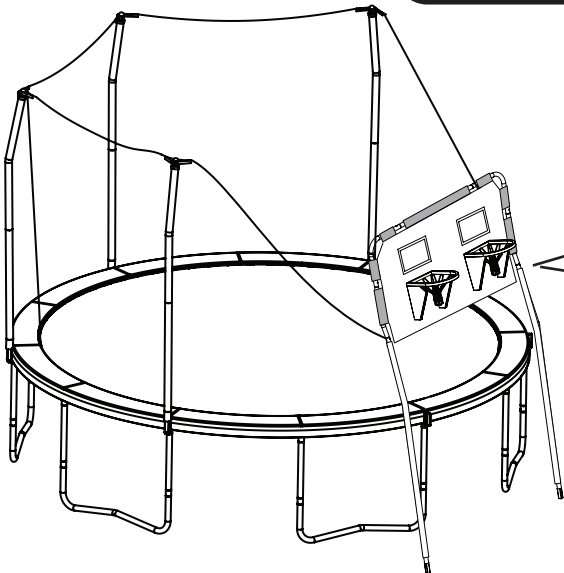

Slide the basketball hoop onto the upper tubes and align the holes of the upper poles, basketball hoop, and the enclosure net and attach together with the two bolts (11-1 or 11-2), four washers (12) and two nuts (13).

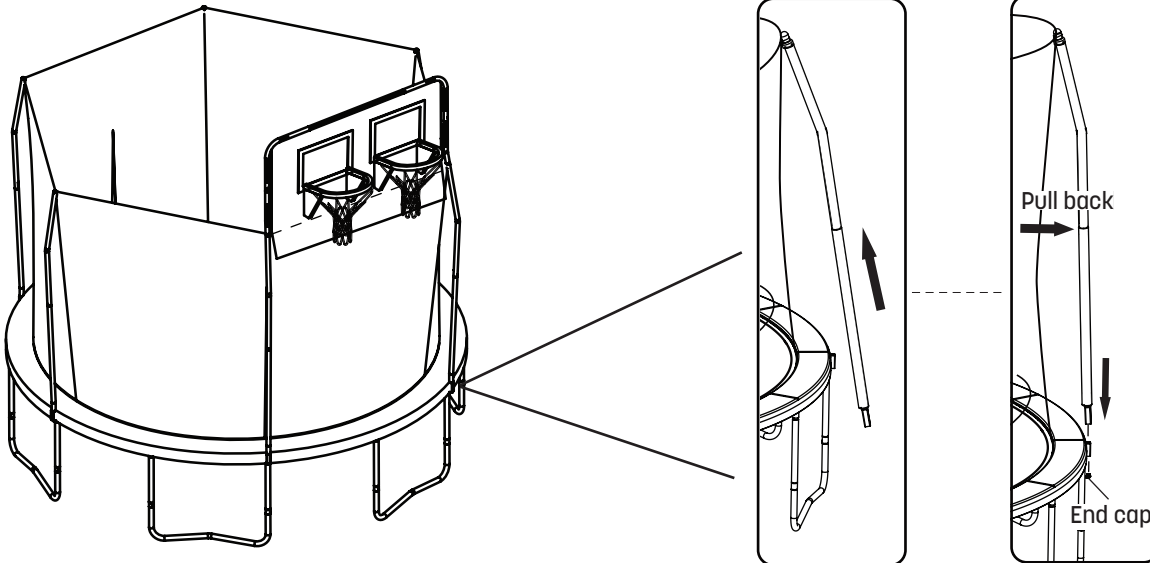
Note: Depending on the model of your trampoline the poles of the game may slide into the enclosure poles rather than onto. Attachment works both ways and will not change the assembly method.

Note: There are two size of bolts (11) for this step to accommodate varying models. Please choose the appropriate one.



STEP 9

Now with two people (one on each side of the game) raise the enclosure poles together and place them in their T-sockets. If you have any other enclosure poles down, place them back up now as well.



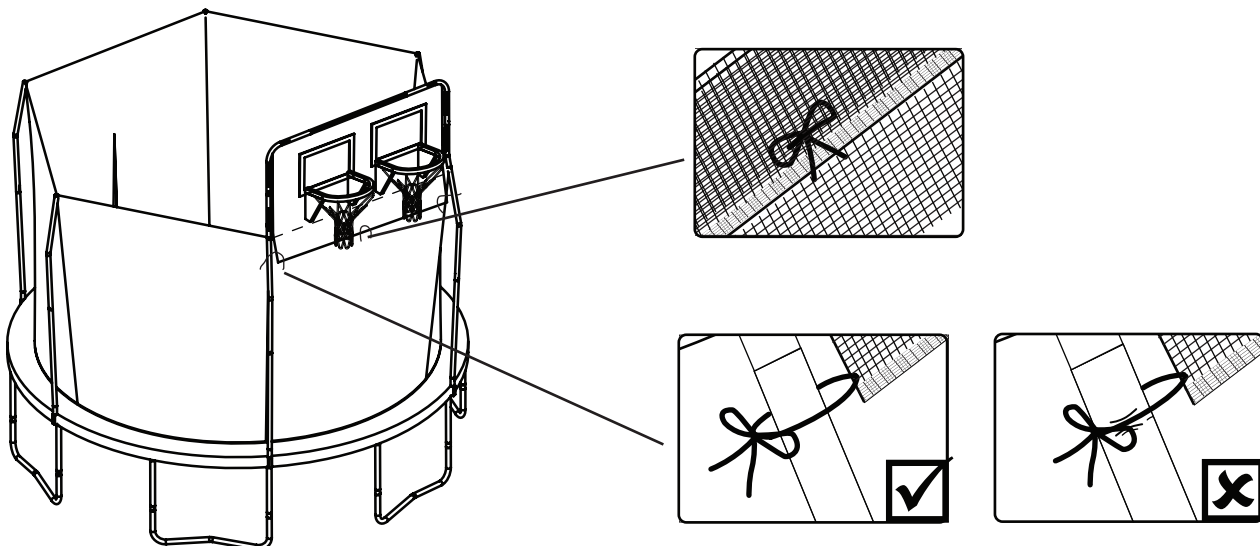
STEP 10



15 String (0.5m) (x3)

To secure the bottom of the game, slide the 3 pieces of string (0.5m) **(15)** through the netting of the game (one on each corner and one in the middle.)

Tie the strings to the poles and enclosure net as shown. **Note: If you tie the strings too tight... you might cut the foam!**



LIMITED WARRANTY

Skywalker Holdings, LLC warrants its products to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use and service conditions. **The steel frame is warranted for three (3) years after the date of purchase. All other parts are warranted for one (1) year after the date of purchase.** Warranty coverage extends only to the original retail purchaser from the date of original purchase. This warranty is only valid concerning products used for residential use. Products used for commercial use, such as schools and daycares, will not be covered.

WHAT IS NOT COVERED?



Weather Damage: The warranty does not cover damage due to the effects or acts of nature, such as earthquakes, wind, hurricanes, tornadoes, lightning, rain, fire, snow, excessive heat and cold conditions and/or sun damage. During the winter months the trampoline soft materials will need to be removed and stored in a dry place out of the snow. If left unprotected in the winter months, some components such as springs, jump mat, spring pad and enclosure, may become damaged, voiding this warranty.



Fading and Rust: Our products are fully galvanized. Skywalker does not warranty against rust or corrosion. Some areas may have higher air salt content, higher humidity, heavier rain and heavier snow. Skywalker does not warranty against fading. We suggest customers use a UV protectant on the frame pad to extend the life of the product.



Loss or damage to Product Due to: Loss or damage caused during shipping or caused by abuse, misuse, improper or abnormal usage or authorized repair are not covered by this warranty and may also void the warranty.



Unauthorized Replacement Parts: The warranty will become void if any defects or damages are associated with the use of unauthorized replacement parts. All replacement parts must be obtained from an authorized agent.



Assembly Service: The warranty does not cover acts or omissions provided by a third-party assembly service. It is the customer's responsibility to check all boxes and confirm all components are included and in their proper condition before installation occurs.

INSPECTION AND REPLACEMENT PARTS:

1. Your product SHOULD BE INSPECTED UPON UNPACKING AND SET UP AND THEREAFTER ON A REGULAR BASIS. WORN, DAMAGED OR BROKEN PARTS SHOULD BE REPLACED IMMEDIATELY AND BEFORE USE.
2. Call the Skywalker Trampoline Customer Service Department at 1-866-603-5867 to file a warranty claim. Be prepared to provide the following information: name, shipping address, a copy of your original sales receipt, a brief description of the problem and cause, model number and serial number. We may also ask for photos of the damaged/defective parts.
3. After reviewing your information and examining your photos, Skywalker Trampolines will make the determination if this part is covered by this warranty. If so, a replacement part will be sent to you.

NOTE: All requested information must be provided in order to review your warranty claim.
