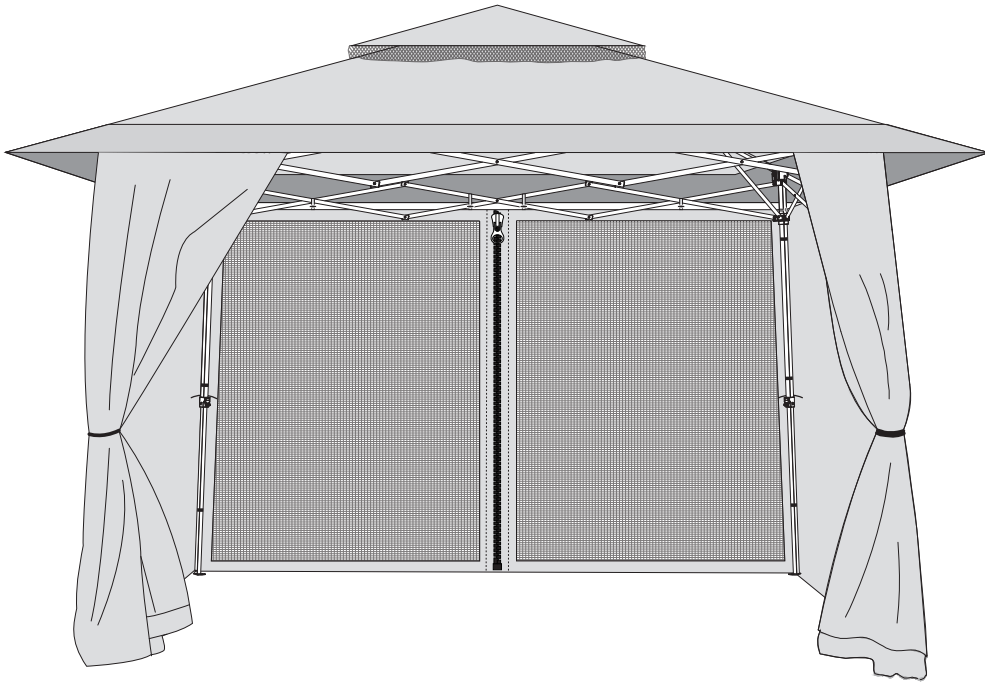

CAUTION: Never set up or continue to use in any rain, wind, or storm conditions, especially lightning storms. Damage can occur to the tent and put you and others in potential danger.







CAUTION: Be careful not to pinch your fingers in the frame during set up and take down.

CAUTION: Do NOT use this tent for permanent shelter. It is designed for temporary use only.




CAUTION: Avoid setting up the tent on steep inclines.

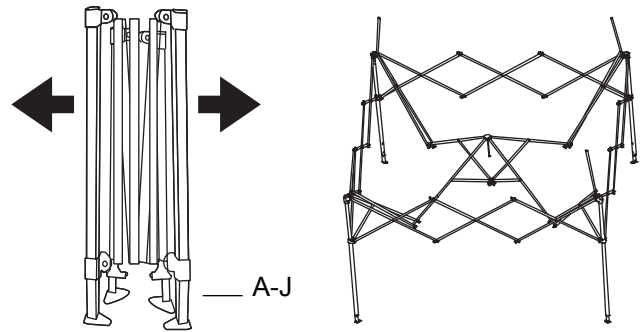

Assembly Instructions

Step 1: Opening the canopy frame

With two persons on the diagonal ends, lift and partially pull the canopy frame (A-J) apart.

Note: At this step do not press the center up yet.



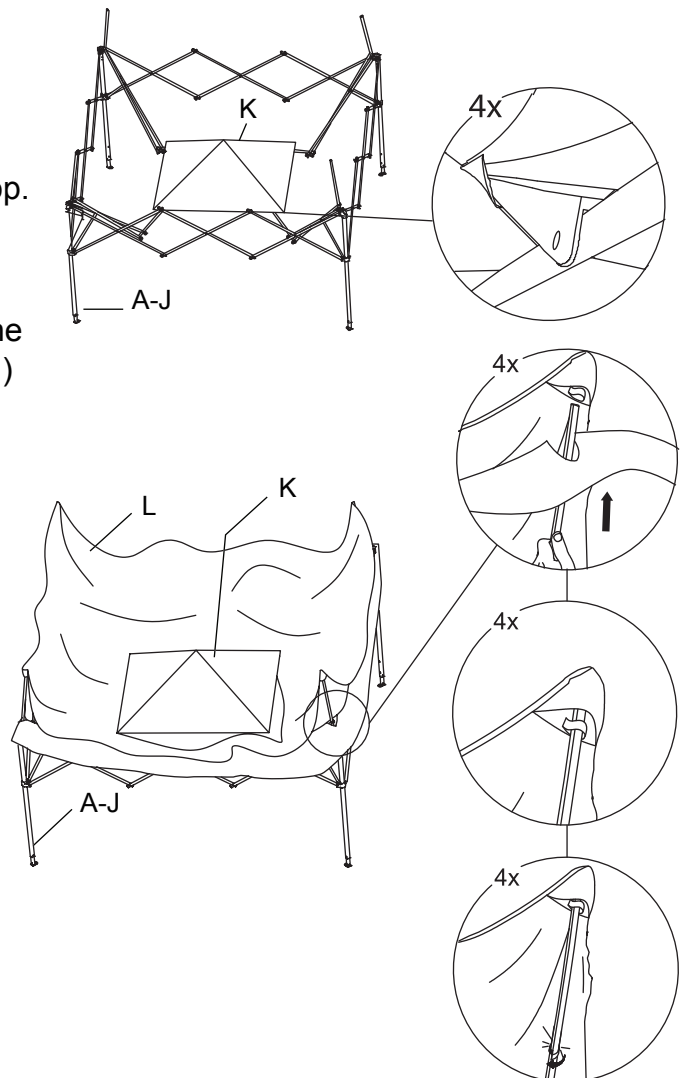
Step 2: Attaching the canopy

Unfold the small top (K) and place it over the open frame (A-J).

Attach the four canopy corners to the frame top.

Unfold the large top (L) and place it over the open frame (A-J). Be sure the neckband of the large top (L) is totally under the small top (K)

Attach the four canopy corners to the awning pole.

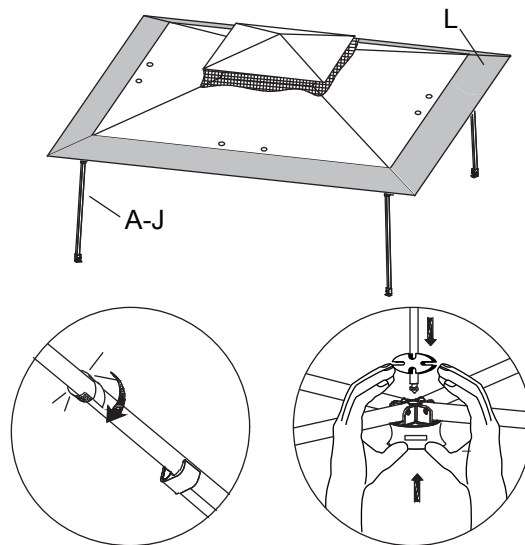

Step 3: Locking the frame

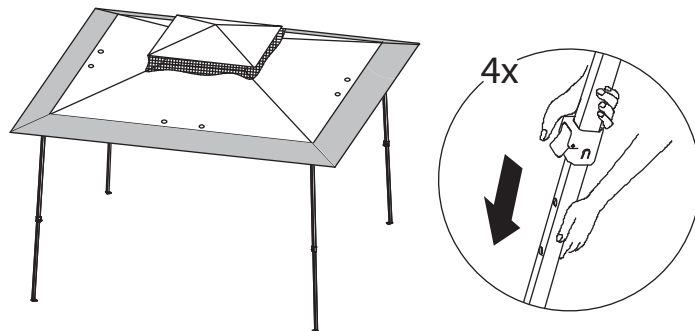
Under the canopy, place one hand on the upper frame and use the other hand to push the central hub straight up until it clicks into the central pole and touches with the bottom tray part.

Finish attaching the large canopy (L) inside the canopy frame (A-J) using the hook and loop closures.



Step 4: Adjusting the canopy height

Press the dark brown button on each leg to raise or lower to adjust the canopy height.

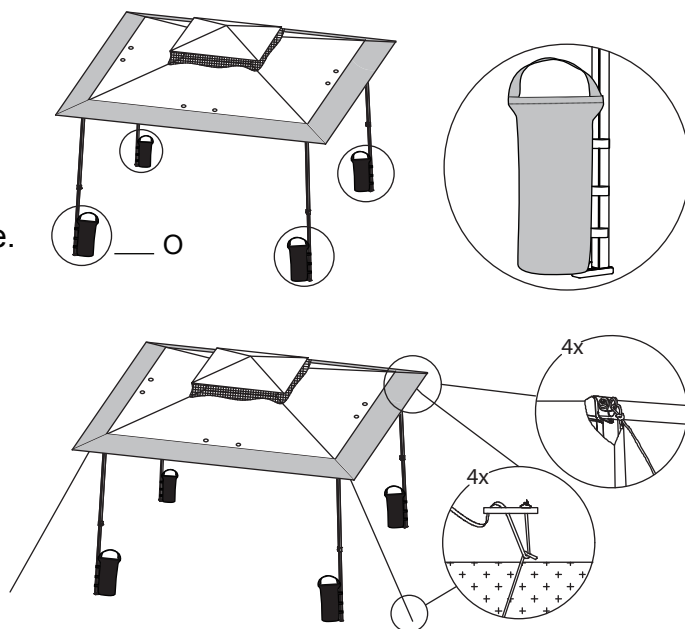


Step 5: Securing the canopy

Fill the weight bag (O) with sand or gravel. Connect the velcro loops of the weight bag (O) around each leg. The included weight bag (O) are designed for quick and easy use.

Tips:Weights must be applied to prevent damage from wind.

Secure the ropes through the metal rings and have the proper tension by adjusting the plastic adjusters on the ropes.

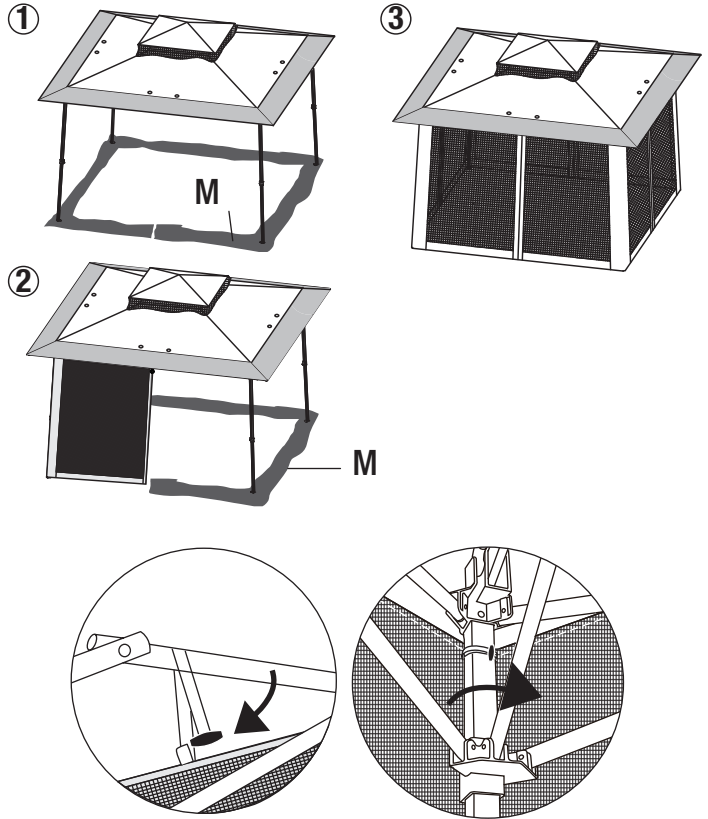
Step 6: Hanging the mosquito netting

Open one zipper of the mosquito netting.
(M) Wrap the wall around the leg. The vertical fabric should go around the outside of the leg.

Start attaching the screen in the middle of any side using the toggle connector over the toptruss to secure the mosquito netting in place.

Repeat with the above steps for remaining sides.

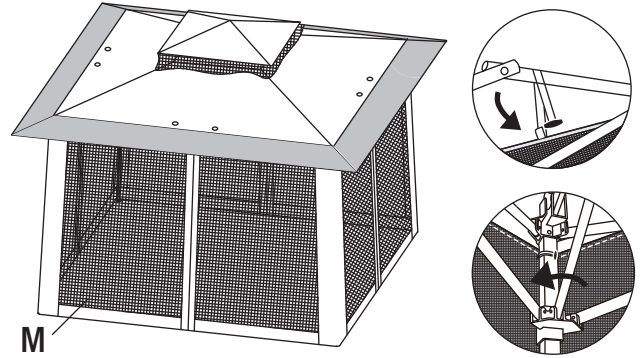
Finally, zip the mosquito netting. (M)



Take down Instructions

Step 1: Taking down the mosquito netting

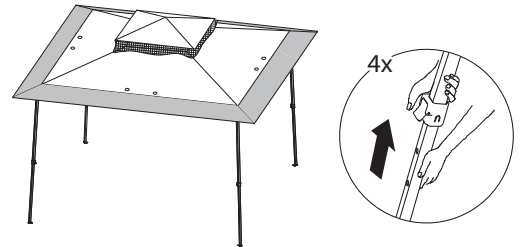
Open one zipper of the mosquito netting. (M)
Go under the canopy and unwrap the toggle from around the canopy frame to take down the mosquito netting.



Step 2: Removing the stakes and retracting the legs

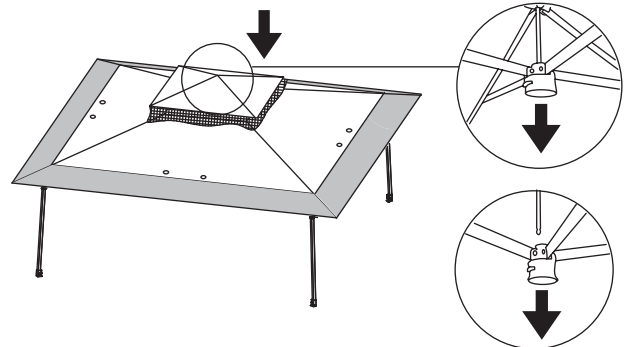
Pull up all stakes from the ground.

Press the push button on each leg and retract the legs to their original height.



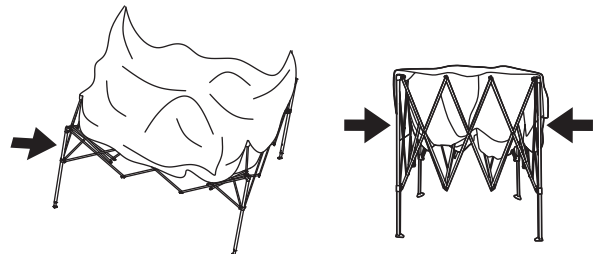
Step 3: Unlocking the canopy

Go under the canopy, press the dark Brown lock button. Pull down the central hub until it is separated from the central pole.



Step 4: Folding the frame

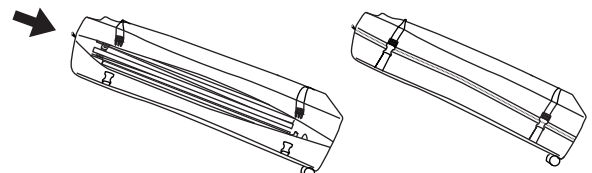
Lift one leg of the frame until the two neighbouring legs are raised off the ground. Push inward until the frame is fully closed.



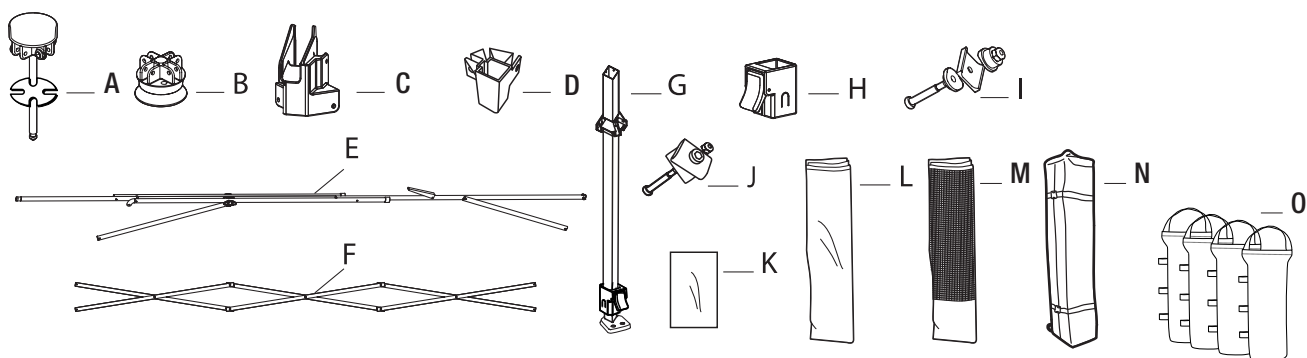
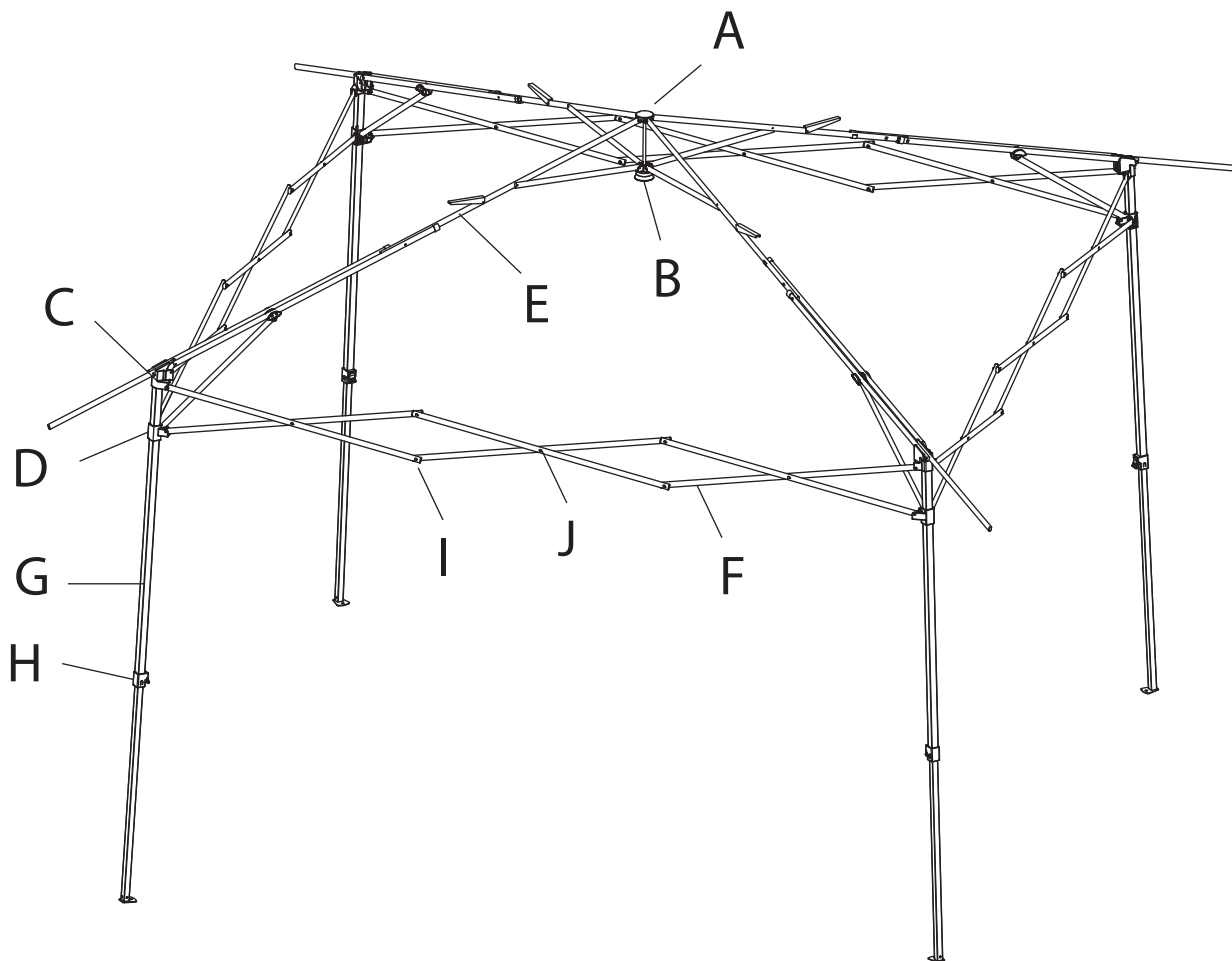
Step 5: Packing the canopy in the wheeled storage bag

With the canopy feet facing the rollers, slide the wheeled storage bag over the closed canopy frame.

Close the zipper on the wheeled storage bag.
