Socket Head Wrench (Included) Furniture Polish and Cloth Carpenters Level Phillips Screw Driver 4 pcs AA Batteries (Not Included), A/C Adapter (Included) (AA Batteries are for store display use only)( A/C Adapter is for residential use only) (4 pcs AAA Batteries for strikers-Not included)

An electric screwdriver is helpful in assembly. However, please set at low torque and use extreme caution with an electric screwdriver because you could overtighten the hardware and strip the screws.

# Assembly Tips

Make sure you understand the following tips before you begin to assemble your game table.


- 1. Start all bolts by hand before tightening.
- 2. Some drawings or images in this manual may not look exactly like your product. Please read and understand the text before starting each assembly step.
- 3. Assembly can be made both simpler and less timely by first unpacking all parts , and matching and organizing them to the Parts Identifier . This will greatly help you become familiar with the parts before and during assembly .
- 4. Some of this assembly can be made easier by placing the parts and building the assembly on a pair of saw horses. A table can be used also as long as the top is well protected from any scratches that could occur. The table or saw horses would need to be structurally strong enough to support this weight.






Place together the four pcs of **P2** Universal Legs as shown in **FIGURE 2**.







#### STEP 4

With the help from another adult, lift the X Leg assembly onto the P1 Main Cabinet and attach using the H1 Hex Head Bolts, H2 Flat Washers and H3





# **ELECTRONIC CONNECTIONS**



-Unscrew and remove cover.

- Insert 4 AA Batteries (Batteries not included). **Make sure polarity is correct.**  - Return cover and reinsert screw.

#### (Store display use only)

Remove the small screw using a small phillips screwdriver and open the battery box, Insert (4) AA batteries (not included) in the order of correct polarity as shown on the inside of the battery box. Then close using the same screwdriver. (If the game will not be used for a long period of the time, we recommend that the batteries be removed)

For display reasons, a battery pack and directions for use are included with this product and in the assembly manual. Please note that the battery pack will only power the LED playfield lights and electronic scoring. The air fan motor will not be powered by the sole battery pack.

Do not plug the A/C adapter into the Junction Box when using batteries.

# **Replacement of LED Light Strip(s)**

#### **STEP ONE :**


Should the LED lights not be working in the rail - Firstly, make sure the A/C Adapter is plugged in to a live A/C outlet properly. Secondly, make sure the A/C Adapter (A5) is tightly plugged into Junction Box outlet under the table. Lastly, make sure all LED Rail light connections are snuggly plugged into the Control Box (C3). At this point, if the LED Rail Lights still not be working, please disconnect the A/C power to the table before proceeding.

A call will be required to our Customer Service Department to acquire the necessary replacement part(s).

#### **STEP TWO :**


If the LED Light Strip needs to be replaced on the **P1** Cabinet inner side, carefully pry the C9 LED Strip Cover out of the apron with the help of a flat blade screwdriver as shown in DETAIL A, then remove the C1 & C2 LED Light Strip from the table.

The LED Light Wire Connection will need to be disconnected first , the connection is under the table , please see page 8 .




#### STEP THREE:

Install the replacement LED Strip C1 & C2 back to the Cabinet Side Rail. Align the male and female connectors of the Lighting LED Strip. Connect the plug of C1 & C2 Lighting LED Strip with C3 Control Box Wire.

# SCOREBOARD CONTROL PANEL OPERATION

Press the POWER button (1) to turn the scoreboard and air motor ON

## LED RAIL LIGHT POWER

Press the POWER button () to turn the rail light ON

## SELECT PLAYING TIME

Press the UP  $\blacktriangle$  or DOWN  $\bigtriangledown$  button to scroll through the playing time options.

- 3 Minutes
- 5 Minutes
- 7 Minutes
- 10 Minutes
- Tug of War (Each goal scored moves the LEDs towards the scoring player. First player to reach 11 wins!)
- Free Play (no time limit)

Press the PLAY button to select the current time and begin playing the game.

#### SOUND

During game play, press the UP  $\blacktriangle$  or DOWN  $\bigtriangledown$  buttons to adjust the volume level.

#### TIMEOUT

Press the PLAY button by during game play to pause the clock and take a timeout.

#### RESET


After the game is over, press any button (Except the POWER BUTTON) to RESET the scoreboard. Press and hold any button (Except the POWER BUTTON) for 3 seconds to RESET the scorer at any time.

This Control Box does have an automatic turn off feature after twenty minutes of inactivity (Air motors and all electronics).


#### **STEP ONE:**

#### **STEP THREE:**


Insert new CR2016 Lithium Battery 3V into LED Puck.



STEP TWO:


Remove CR2016 Lithium Battery 3V from LED Puck.


#### IF BATTERY HOLDER BRACKET MOVES, RE-INSTALL IT TO LED PUCK AS SHOWN IN DIAGRAM.

Install back cap and secure screws with Phillps Screwdriver (not provided).






#### Helpful Hint:

The LED puck battery will last approximately 7 hours of continuous play. The puck battery is not rechargeable. Be sure to turn the switch to the "OFF" position whe**n not in use to conserve your battery life.**

# **First Time Battery Installation:**

Locate battery compartment for this product . Use alkaline batteries for maximum performance .

Remove battery compartment cover .

Install new batteries only after reading the "Battery Information NOTICE" !

Replace compartment cover and secure cover.

#### **IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION**

Please retain this information for future reference. Batteries must be installed / replaced by an adult .

# Notice:

- 1. Remove and replace batteries when the electrical features of this product work slowly or are not functional .

# CARE AND USE OF YOUR TABLE


- 1. Use spray furniture polish to clean all exterior surfaces of your table.
- 2. Use spray funiture polish on the AH playing surface with motor running. This will protect the playing surface + make the pucks go faster.
- 3. This product is intended for **INDOOR** use only.
- 4. DO NOT sit, climb or lean on the table.
- 5. **DO NOT** drag the table when moving it. This will damage the legs.
- 6. **DO NOT** set drinks on the table.
- 7. The purchase of a table cover will both protect and help keep clean the entire top of the table.
- 8. Use a carpenters level to properly level the table using the enclosed A6 leveling shims.

# **INSTRUCTIONS FOR LEVELING A GAME TABLE**

- Assemble game table according to the instruction.
- Any type of level would be sufficient to perform this procedure. However, a two-foot level is recommended.
- Before leveling, make sure level is placed on the playing surface if possible, not the rails.
- Level the ends: Place the level on the playing surface and adjust the height by placing shims (A6) underneath the leg opposite of which the bubble in the level favors until the bubble rests in the middle of the level.



- Repeat the step above to the opposite end of the game table.
- Next, level the length of the table. Place the level next to the side of the table and adjust the height to position the bubble in the middle of the level, using the shims opposite of which the bubble in the level favors.
- Repeat the step above to the opposite length of the table.
- Recheck both short ends to ensure bubble is in the middle on the level.
- Depending on the surface the game table sits, especially deep pile carpenting, the game table needs to settle for 24 hours. Recheck the level on each side of the table after 24 hours.
